<b>Chardonnay, Almyra – Dom Skouras,</b> <i>Peloponnese, Greece</i> Aged in French oak and stainless steel. Rich, complex flavors with a lush finish.	54.00	
<b>Assyrtiko, Atlantis – Argyros,</b> <i>Santorini, Greece</i> Vibrant, gravely mineral, aromas of unripe peaches and nice salinity balances the acidity. Stainless steel.	61.00

<b>Garnacha, Zestos Old Vine – San Martin, Valdeiglesias, Spain</b> Supple in texture, offering juicy black raspberry and cherry flavors and a gentle minerality.	31.00	10.00
<b>Agiorgitiko, Omikron – Omikron, Nemea Valley, Corinth, Greece</b> A light-bodied wine partly aged with a very smooth finish. Great berry flavors.	31.00	10.00

<b>Cannonau, Rosso Costera, DOC – Argiolas, Sardinia, Italy</b> Deep color and fully bodied. Rich and spicy. Flavors of ripe strawberries, black cherries, herbs and spices.	42.00	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Seven Oaks – J. Lohr, Paso Robles, California</b> Big fruit in the nose, modest tannins, very easy drinking Cabernet.	47.00	14.00
<b>Xinomavro, Young Vines – Thymiopoulos, Naoussa, Greece</b> Complex aromas of fresh cherry, blackberry and plum give way to an elegant and herbaceous finish.	45.00	13.50
<b>Pinot Noir, Stafford Hill – Holloran, Willamette, Oregon</b> Organic. Balanced with black cherry and hints of spice on the nose, ample fruit on the palate with a long finish.	51.00	
<b>Agiorgitiko – Nasiakos, Nemea Valley, Corinth, Peloponnese, Greece</b> Dry. Rounded and fruity on the palate. Lightly spiced aromas of blackberries and forest fruits with creamy notes.	51.00	
<b>Mandilaria, Atlantis – Argyros, Santorini, Greece</b> Fruit forward with a smooth, spicy, and slightly toasted background. Minerality and earthy tones.	61.00	
<b>Axia Florina Syrah Xinomavro, Alpha Estate – Macedonia, Greece</b> Purple red color. Hints of ripe blackberry. Full mouth with vanilla aroma. Well rounded tannins and wood tones.	57.00	
<b>Sagrantino di Montefalco – Colepetrone, Umbria, Italy</b> Savory. Tastes of dried cherry with spices, hint of vanilla, dried fruits and chocolate with a long, velvety finish.	60.00	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Roth Estate – Alexander Valley, Calif</b> Bold, full-bodied and rich. Dark in color, aromas of intense dark fruit, cassis and cocoa powder.	64.00	
<b>Cabernet / Merlot / Agiorgitiko – Amethystos, Macedonia, Greece</b> Full-Bodied red wine that is packed with flavors of smoke, spice and red fruits, with a long and spicy finish.	71.00
